

MCS TRANSPORTATION GUIDELINES

In order for private vehicles to be used to transport students on school-sponsored activities, the school-approved guidelines must be followed in each event:

- The AD and/or MCS School Director approve the transportation.
- Each student's parent or guardian is notified in writing regarding the transportation arrangement and gives written consent before a student athlete is transported in a privately owned motor vehicle.
- The driver must be at least 25 years of age and hold a valid driver's license.
- The owner has liability insurance with limits of \$250,000 per person and \$500,000 per occurrence.
- The vehicle is in acceptable working order and properly registered with the State.
- Students must be transported in designated seating positions and shall be required to use the occupant crash-protection system provided by the vehicle manufacturer, unless the student's physical condition prohibits such use.

Note: Private vehicle owners who transport students to any school-sponsored activity must provide the following information to the AD prior to departure to the event: the name of driver, a copy of the driver's valid license, and a copy of valid liability insurance.
